

Shipwrecked by whales – survivor's own incredible

COURAGEOUS Simone and William Butler endured 66 days of torture adrift in a life raft after their sailboat sank in the Pacific Ocean. Simone, 52, and William, 80, each lost 50 lbs. on a meager diet of raw fish they caught with their bare hands. They survived a shark attack and were almost dead from dehydration, sunburn and salt-water sores when they were finally plucked from the sea by a rescue ship.
